PIVOT TO HYBRID PLAN & INFORMATION



2020 - 2021 SCHOOL YEAR

Dear Jaguar Parent or Guardian:

Given that the alert level for Lucas County dropped to level 2, HSAT will begin hybrid instruction next month only for families who have already committed to our hybrid instructional option. Our first day of hybrid instruction will be Monday, October 19th – which is the first day of our 2nd quarter.

In accordance with our hybrid plan, which was shared with you in July, students will be divided into three groups and will report to school as follows:

K-4 students will report M, Tu, Th, & Fri

5-12 students in Group A will report M & Tu

5-12 students in Group B will report Th & Fri

We will still continue our fully online option for those parents who already committed to this instructional plan this summer. Important Reminder: you will have the option to reconsider your choice at the end of the first semester (in December). If, at that time, you wish to transition to the hybrid option you may submit a formal request (via email) to HSAT Administration, but the ability to do so will depend on space availability.

Parents who committed to the Hybrid option and no longer feel safe in sending their student to the building for academic instruction, may still submit a formal request (via email) to HSAT Administration to switch to the Fully Online option.

**Students enrolled in the hybrid option will still complete the same instruction as the students enrolled in the online option.*

The only difference between these two options is that students enrolled in the hybrid option will complete their work under the supervision of a teacher.

We will share more details with you in the days and weeks ahead pertaining to items such as daily bell schedule, mask & social distancing policies, school buses, arrival/dismissal plan, etc... Please be on the lookout!

Thank you for all you do parents & guardians. We look forward to seeing many of our students back in the building 2nd quarter! Until then, have a great weekend and we will see everyone online on Monday!
